
Pick up times in Oakmont: 8:30, 9:30, 10:30, 11:30, 1:30, 2:30, 3:30

You MUST CALL RCAC at least 1 hour before you want a ride at 412-828-1062

THERE IS NO BUS AT NOON OR 12:30PM

COST OF A ONE-WAY RIDE - \$2/PERSON

Purchase a bus pass at the center. Present the pass at the time of the ride; if you do not have your pass, the ride is \$2/each way Bus Pass: 40 rides - \$60 (\$1.50/ride) 20 rides - \$33 (\$1.65/ride) 10 rides - \$18 (\$1.80/ride)
