At this special time of year, the board, staff and volunteers of RCAC are very thankful for another year of friendship, support and growth. With the help of many supporters, donors and volunteers, RCAC proved once again that when we work hard together, we can accomplish spectacular goals.

Now it is time for us once again to appeal to you for support. This past year, we were able to provide approximately 12,000 home delivered meals and over 5,400 meals were served at the Center. Monthly, over 1,000 people came through our doors and we provided over 700 trips on the Twin Boro Bus. Our participants have also been busy this year. They are meeting monthly with the staff to plan activities. They have traveled to different events all over Pittsburgh, they learned line dancing, tai chi, Zumba, and many other classes. 
Pick up times in Oakmont: 8:30, 9:30, 10:30, 11:30, 1:30, 2:30, 3:30

THERE IS NO BUS AT NOON OR 12:30PM

COST OF A ONE-WAY RIDE - \$2/PERSON

Purchase a bus pass at the center. Present the pass at the time of the ride; if you do not have your pass, the ride is \$2/each way Bus Pass: 40 rides - \$60 (\$1.50/ride) 20 rides - \$33 (\$1.65/ride) 10 rides - \$18 (\$1.80/ride)
